WOLFGANG AMADEUS MOZART  
1756-1791



Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart was born in Salzburg in 1756 and he died in Vienna in 1791. He learned to compose music from his father, Leopold Mozart.

Despite his short life, his rapid pace of composition from an early age resulted in more than 800 works representing almost every western classical Genre of his time.

His most famous compositions include Symphonies 40 and 38, Magic Flute, Rondo alla Turca, and the operas "The Marriage of Figaro" and "Don Giovanni".
